This fellowship is a fantastic opportunity to work on cutting-edge research projects, use state-of-the-art research facilities and be part of some of the best research groups worldwide!

Suppose you are applying for the postdoctoral scheme from the [UK](#) as I did. In that case, I recommend you do it through the respective overseas nominating authorities for this scheme in your country to maximise your chances. These are The Royal Society and The British Academy for the UK. This scheme will likely open in late 2021 or early 2022, so I recommend contacting potential supervisors ASAP.
